This is what Jesus does for us on the cross and through the resurrection.



theme Being changed

1 Peter 1:3-10

read

Pick a few boxes and worship together at home

This [light refraction experiment](#) takes only a few minutes to set up and uses basic materials, but it's a great way to show kids how light travels. You'll draw two arrows on a sticky note, stick it to the wall, then fill a clear water bottle with water. As you move the water bottle in front of the arrows, the arrows will appear to change the direction they're pointing. This is because of the refraction that occurs when light passes through materials like water and plastic.

- Materials Needed**
- Sticky note
 - Marker
 - Transparent water bottle
 - Water

Explain: The light makes the arrows change direction. As Jesus shines his light in our lives, our lives are changed.

Have one person put on lots of items of clothing, they can be as silly as you like! Next have them stand in front of everyone for 10 seconds. Then ask that person to disappear and take off three items. When they return, guess what has changed!

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

Explain that God sees and loves all of this and wants to help us with it all.



theme Embracing Brokenness


Pick a few boxes and worship together at home




